We can have our lunch in the picnic area and then check out some more of the 6000 acres sanctuary on our own. There are walking trails, wooded hills, wetlands, lakes and streams. The purpose of the Sanctuary is the active conservation of wildlife; this is accomplished by preservation of habitats and propagation of native plants. The gardens and walking trails represent habitats found throughout New England. There are natural history exhibits and museums on the property. We will get to Monson by carpooling. Registration and payment is required by June 3, so that there is time to arrange the cars and drivers from different parts of RI.
