THE RIWPS INVENTORY COMMITTEE will conduct one or more surveys during the growing season covering as much of the specified area as possible (within reason) for the purpose of identifying wild trees, shrubs, and herbaceous plants. RIWPS will provide a list of the plants found.

- *RIWPS will conduct an inventory only with written permission of the landowner and/or the landowner's signature at the bottom of this form.*
- *RIWPS cannot guarantee that we will locate every plant species on the property.*
- *RIWPS reserves the right to share information from the plant inventory with the RI Natural Heritage Program and the RI Natural History Survey, particularly any information regarding the location of rare or endangered plants.*

IN RETURN FOR THESE SERVICE THE PLANT LIST REQUESTOR WILL:

- provide RIWPS with a map of the site clearly indicating the boundaries of the property to be surveyed.
- allow RIWPS Inventory teams access to the property at mutually convenient times.
- pay a fee of \$50 per visit payable within two weeks after receipt of each plant list, which will be presented after each visit.
